General Information

☐ Microchip your pet		Note: Microchipping is not a requirement for your pet to enter the FSM, however we highly recommend all pets be microchipped before travel.

☐ Rabies Vaccination ☐ Get your pet used to its carrier	Ensure your pet is vaccinated against rabies as well as the following: Dogs – Distemper, hepatitis and canine parvovirus Cats – Feline Panleucopaenia, Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis/Calici Give your pet at least a month before your flight to become familiar with the travel carrier. This will minimize his stress during travel.	Note: Pets may not travel until <u>at least</u> 30 days after the rabies vaccine. (The day they receive the vaccine is considered Day 0, so if your pet is vaccinated on the 1 st of the month, the earliest they may travel is the 31 st of the month).

☐ Internal Parasite Treatment	All animals need to be treated against echinococcosis-hydatidosis, roundworm, hookworm, and whipworms within 3 days of export.

releases them.

- The island of Pohnpei does not have a permanently stationed veterinarian. Dr. Joseph is the only veterinarian who regularly

 • There are separate rules governing the flies into the island to provide veterinary care.
 - Make sure to get your pet carrier that meets airline regulations.

- Fit your pet with a collar that can't get caught in carrier doors. It is also advisable to put a temporary ID with your destination and contact information on your pet as well.
- · Make sure that your pet's nails have been clipped to protect against them getting hooked in the carrier's door, holes, and other crevices.
